Notice to all exhibitors of cattle:

The Coonamble Showground Brucellosis Status will be declared a provisionally free area for the period in which the Show will take place. Exhibitors are requested to contact their LPHA Veterinary Officer or Brucellosis Officer regarding movements of cattle to and from the showground.

CONDITIONS

- The committee reserves the right to cancel or combine classes or sections at their discretion.
- The Society will not hold itself responsible for any loss of livestock or other exhibition at the show, or any damage thereto.
- Every exhibitor must be the bonafide owner of the exhibit at judging day.
- All exhibits in Stud beef Section to be registered with the respective Society..
- All commercial Cattle & all breeds of Stud Beef cattle to be on showground for the second day of the show, 24th May 2023 before 8am
- Entry fee must be paid at the time of entry.
- Prizes: The Show Society ribbons and trophies as donated.
- The Judge will not be bound to grant an award to any exhibit which in his / her opinion considers insufficient merit.
- Power and wash provided for grooming.
- In the event of any dispute as to whether entries comply with the rules the decision of the Stewards will be final.
- All bulls over 12 months to be rung
- All cattle in registration breed classes must be led.
- All cattle will be paraded in order of birth, youngest first

The age of beef cattle to be up to and including 24th May 2023

Led School Steer & Heifer Section – 8am start

1. Domestic Steer or Heifer to be fed on.

Description: suitable for finished weight of 300-400kg as of 10th August 2023
(Approx 150-300kgs on the day of showing milk teeth only purebred or crossbred
Condition Score 2-3)

2. Heavy Domestic Steer or Heifer to be fed on.

Description: Suitable for finished weight of 400-500kg as of 10th August 2023
(Approx 300 – 400kgs on the day of showing milk teeth only purebred or Crossbred
Condition score 2-3)

3. Export Steer or Heifer to be fed on.

Description: suitable for finished weight of 550+kg as of 10th August 2023
(Approx 400+kgs on the day of showing) milk teeth only purebred or Crossbred
Condition score 2 – 3

4. Replacement Heifer

Description: Purebred or crossbred, No more than 2 permanent teeth

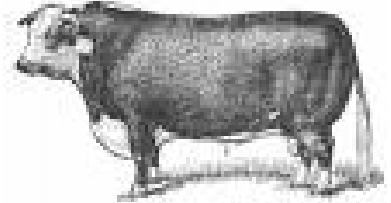
