## Adults and over 15 years

- Any knitted item

**Conditions:**

All entries must be suitable for being on display for 4 weeks.

- All entries to have name securely attached in an inconspicuous place
- A properly completed, signed entry form must be received from each entrant – can be downloaded from [www.coonambleshow.com](http://www.coonambleshow.com)
- Exhibits must be presented in a complete and clean state
- Entries should have been completed in the previous 12 months
- Entries must be the bona fide work of the exhibitor
- Entries to be delivered to Castlereagh Electrical **in the mornings only**, from **Wednesday 13th May to Friday 22nd May**. **NO LATE ENTRIES CAN BE ACCEPTED**
- Entries must remain on display until 19th June. They can be then collected from shopfronts 10am – 2pm on that day, after which they must be collected from Castlereagh Electrical within the following week
- All entries not collected by 26th June will be disposed of
- Lego – should be provided attached to a standard Lego baseboard, and be brought in an enclosed container (eg cardboard box) to minimise the risk of lost pieces
